



POLISHER TRAINING CHECKLIST

1. Drive clean & dry vehicle into the Auto Butler Polisher Bay with the front tire against stop plate on floor.
2. Place car in park, set the Parking Brake when necessary.
3. Place keys on machine next to control panel to prevent accidental lockout.

4. Inspect the vehicle for the following:

- a. Cleanliness (No water spots, tar, dried bugs, etc.).
- b. No tire/trim dressing has been applied beforehand.
- c. Antennas lowered or removed, and all Windows, Doors and Tailgates are Closed.
- d. No loose parts, moldings, pin striping, etc.
- e. **Identify Factory or Aftermarket add-ons that may require operator to retract the pads over/around.**
- f. Fold in oversized/towing mirrors.
- g. **Install Windshield Wiper Protectors.**

Do not operate the Auto Butler Polisher while using portable electronics or distracted in any way. Cell Phone use prohibited when machine is running.

5. Spray a light even mist of AUTO BUTLER LUSTRE-RENU POLISH (Step 1) to all painted surfaces of the vehicle. Avoid spraying directly onto non-painted plastics, rubber moldings, etc. Remove accidental overspray immediately.
6. Place top and side pads onto the vehicle, unless necessary to avoid sensitive areas.

ALWAYS RETRACT THE TOP PAD OVER THESE AREAS:

Failure to do so can result in vehicle damage.

- **Front Windshield / All Rear windows / Any Glass with a Wiper Blade**
- **Spoilers / Wind Deflectors / Bug Deflectors**
- **Luggage / Utility Racks**
- **Convertibles / Soft Tops**
- **Pickup Beds**

WHEN IN DOUBT, STOP MACHINE AND ASK OR RECTRACT PADS AROUND CONCERN

7. Start machine, run full cycle down & back, retracting over/around sensitive areas. (Keep feet/hands clear of machine tracks/pads and do not enter pads while machine is running).
8. **Repeat steps 5-6-7 using AUTO BUTLER PAINT SEALANT (Step 2).**
9. Remove any residual product, place Auto Butler window decal in window.
10. Conduct final inspection and deliver the vehicle.
